RE:

Licensing of Investigators by Alabama Private Investigation Board

The Office of Indigent Defense Services (OIDS) has been advised by the Alabama Private Investigation Board (APIB) of a change in policy for the licensing of investigators retained by counsel for indigent clients. Investigators retained by counsel have been exempted from the licensing requirement of Alabama Code §34-25B-3 pursuant to §34-25B-24(8)(c). Effective January 1, 2024, APIB will no longer consider investigators retained by counsel in indigent matters exempt from the licensing requirement of §34-25B-3 pursuant to the aforementioned-exemption section. As such, effective January 1, 2024, any private investigator retained by counsel on behalf of an indigent client must be licensed by the APIB pursuant to §34-25B-1, et al., to receive payment from the Fair Trial Tax Fund.
